was found.

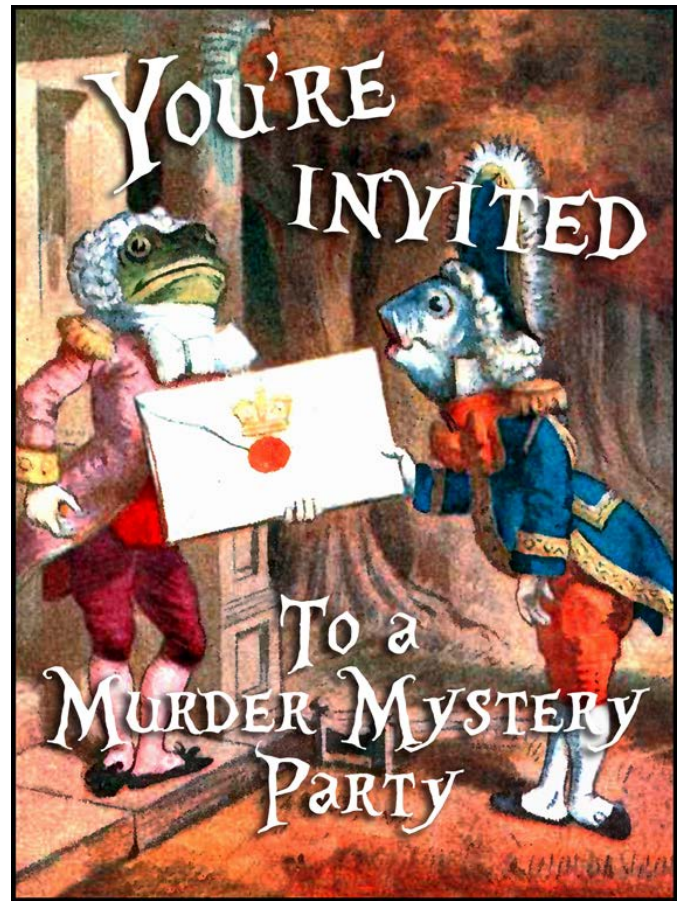
All twisted up and twisted down, and partly
